## **Parents and Entrants:**

The Judah Heritage Festival Scholarship Pageant will be held on June 18, 2019 at the Valley Mission Church of the Nazarene at 6:30 p.m. Doors will open at 6:00 p.m. Admission charge will be \$2 at the door. Children 4 years and under are free.

**The registration fee is \$30 and is nonrefundable.**

A mandatory parent meeting will be held on June 1, 2019 at 3 p.m. and will take place at the Judah Community Park shelter house on Hillcrest Way behind Johnny Junxions.

There will be three rehearsal sessions prior to the pageant at Valley Mission Church of the Nazarene. The followings dates and times are subject to change:

Monday June 3rd 6 p.m.-8 p.m.

Monday June 10th 6 p.m.-8 p.m.

Monday June 17th 6 p.m.- ??

These are **CLOSED** rehearsals. Parents will not be permitted to stay while practice is in session.

Contestants will begin interviews at 2 p.m. the day of the pageant. All girls should arrive by 1:30 p.m

**Judging and scores will be as follows:**

**Interview: 20 points** - The interview portion of the pageant is worth 40% of the contestants overall score.

**The following categories are each worth 20% of the contestants overall score:**

**Theme wear: 10 points** - The theme wear portion of the pageant will be judged on creativeness, originality, and stage presence. Theme wear will need to be approved prior to the pageant. After it has been approved, there may be no changes made.

**Formal wear: 10 points** - The formal wear portion of the pageant will be judged on poise and appropriate selection of dress.

**On stage question: 10 points** - After formal wear has concluded, contestants will all be brought back on stage in their gowns to individually answer a randomly selected question in front of the audience.

## **Crowning etc.:**

Crowning will take place (weather permitting) at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday June 20, 2019 on stage at the festival. **NO** admission charge. In the event of inclement weather, the crowning will be moved to Valley Mission Church of the Nazarene. If a contestant receives a title of any sort, she will be asked to stay for the duration of the evening.

Once awarded a title, the presence of the Queen, 1st runner-up, 2nd runner-up, and Miss Congeniality is expected at the festival throughout the weekend, barring any family emergencies.

A strict weather appropriate dress code will be enforced. Any issues could result in termination of any title.

Overall, the goal is to have fun, make new friends, and show others the pride we have in our festival and community.

## Judah Heritage Festival Scholarship Pageant Rules and Regulations

1. The pageant will be held on Tuesday June 18, 2019.
2. Entrant must abide by the rules of the Judah Heritage Festival Board now in effect or as announced hereafter.
3. Entrant agrees that the time, manner, and method of judging shall be solely within the discretion of the JHFB and that the decision of the judges is final.
4. Entrants age shall not be less than seventeen nor more than twenty-two years on Jan. 1st of the pageant year. Entrant must provide either a copy of her birth certificate or driver's license as proof of age.
5. An entrant must be enrolled in high school or a high school graduate and enrolled in college.
6. Entrant must be a resident of Lawrence County.
7. An entrant must be of good moral character and shall possess poise, personality, intelligence, charm and the ability to speak in public.
8. An entrant is required to appear in three clothing changes during the competition: business attire, theme wear, and evening gown.
9. An entrant must attend all scheduled rehearsals and be there until the conclusion of the Judah Heritage Festival events.
10. The **\$30** entree fee is **nonrefundable**.

11. **Titles will be as follows:** JHFSP Queen (who will receive a \$500 scholarship; payment will be made by check to the winner's college choice or as otherwise determined by the JHFB committee)

1st Runner-up

2nd Runner-up

Miss Congeniality (A Directors Award will also be given but is not considered a title)

12. Judging will be based on the following:

**Interview**.....20 points

**Theme Wear**.....10 points

**Evening Gown**.....10 points

**On Stage Question**.....10 points

13. The winning entrant agrees to the following appearances as a representative of the Judah Heritage Festival:

1. Bedford 4th of July Parade
2. Persimmon Festival Parade
3. Bedford Christmas Parade
4. Dogwood Festival Parade

14. Each entrant must submit an essay of **100 words or less** describing herself.

This will be read by the emcee during the Theme Wear competition and will not be judged.

15. **ALL** pageant applications **MUST** be in the hands of the pageant director by **May 31st**. Applications are to be mailed directly and postmarked. No hand delivered, or e-mail applications will be accepted.

### Contract for the 2019 JHF Queen

Being selected as the 2019 JHF Queen carries with it many responsibilities. You will be a representative for the Judah Festival and the entire community that surrounds it. You will be required to attend a minimum of four parades during your reign. You will also be given a selection of events that previous queens attended and enjoyed. You will also be able to attend these events if you so choose.

You are to wear your crown and JHF sash to all events.

When you attend these events, you are to dress appropriately. Shorts or blue jeans are not allowed at any event. If it is a summer parade, capri pants or a summer dress is acceptable, but must be pre approved by the pageant director.

When traveling to events, you are never to travel alone. You must have an adult such as a parent, grandparent, aunt, older sibling, etc. Boyfriends are not allowed to accompany you. They are a distraction and you are there to do a job.

You are an ambassador of the Judah Heritage Festival and you must conduct yourself in a manner that reflects the community and their values. Always take time for photos with children. They look up to you and aspire to be you one day. You are not to be on your cell phone unless it is to contact the individual chaperoning you, if you get separated, etc.

You will work directly with Alivia when scheduling your appearances. You are never to agree to an appearance without communicating with the director.

If you are unable to fulfill your duties, the first runner up will be asked to attend events and represent the JHF.
